




FROM THE DESK OF THE DISTRICT GOVERNOR, LION MICHAEL O'LONERGAN

SPOTLIGHT ON LION ED WEESSIES

This month the newsletter presents to you one of four charter members in our club, Mr. Ed Weessies. The challenge in doing a biography on Lion Ed is the sheer volume of Lions history that Ed has in his almost 45 years as a Lion. Currently he is Membership Chair and Club Administrator. Born and raised in Kalamazoo he was a Hospital Corpsman in the U.S. Coast Guard from 1963-67. Ed married his late wife Jan in 1965. Together they have children Kimberly (Kim) and son Mike, a member of our club, and 5 grandchildren. Ed is active in the Roman Catholic Church. For many years he was the elected clerk for Laketon Township.

He was Charter Lion Tamer, Charter Night Chairman, and from 1982-2000 club secretary earning the 100% Secretary's Award each year. He has received more awards than can be listed on a single page. In July

2022, he was inducted into the Lions of Michigan Foundation's Hall of Fame. District committees has had served on include Constitution and ByLaws, Credentials, Extension, Leader Dogs for the Blind, Leadership Development, USA/Canada Lions Leadership Forum, and Welcome Homes for the Blind. In some of these aforementioned areas Ed has also served on the multiple district level. He has chaired district conventions and served as Cabinet Secretary/Treasurer for PID Dennis Cobler when he was District Governor. He has received the International President's Award for Humanitarian Service in 1994 and the International President's Leadership medal in 2004. He has more than 10 progressive Melvin Jones fellowship awards. He has received the Granville and Betty Cutler Leadership award, a Ken Lautzenheiser and a Helen Keller award, and a SA Dodge Distinguished Service Award (MD11). My apologies to Ed for not including his other accomplishments. He is often the Lion behind the scenes filling out forms, getting permission for events, and seeing that service of other Lions members is recognized. We are proud to have him as a member of the Muskegon Northside Lions.
