



COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECTS OF THE MUSKEGON NORTHSIDE LIONS

Projects include but are not limited to the following:

- Provide eye examinations, glasses, hearing testing and hearing aids for those in need, working with the Muskegon Community Health Project.
- Construct access ramps for the handicapped.
- Sponsor food trucks for the needy.
- Provide scholarships to two deserving high school seniors each year from North Muskegon and Reeths-Puffer High Schools.
- Coordinate the restoration of the Veterans' Memorial Causeway Park as well as providing manpower to do clean-up.
- Provide a Christmas Shopping trip for local underprivileged grade school children living in the Reeths-Puffer & North Muskegon School Districts.
- Provide financial aid to those within the north side who have suffered a catastrophic event.
- Provide hearing and vision screenings to pre-school and elementary school students.
- Restore our forests by planting trees.

Note that 100% of all funds raised from the public is returned to the public through some of the above projects and others that are deemed to be in the public good. None of those funds are used to benefit our club or its members.
